- Contact family and friends back home and let them know that you have arrived safely
 - Attend all Welcome events to get the information you need, and to connect with other students
 - Ask your landlord/the Student Union's Housing Service for a "Wohnungsgeberbestätigung"
 - Register at your city's Resident's Registration Office
 - Put your name on your letter box
 - If needed** apply for your residence permit (does not apply to everyone!)
 - Open a bank account
 - Connect with your assigned buddy or join our Buddy Program [here](#)
 - Find your local supermarket, pharmacy, shopping area, etc. (Please take note that all shops are entirely closed on Sundays as well as on [public holidays](#))
 - Activate your [IdM](#) account and put in your German address
 - If you are living in a dormitory, hand in your enrolment certificate to the Housing Service (Download on [Campo](#))
 - Buy your [Deutschland Ticket](#) for public transport
