- ☐ Ask your landlord/the Student Union's Housing Service for a "Wohnungsgeberbestätigung"
- ☐ Register at your city's Resident's Registration Office
- ☐ Put your name on your letter box
- ☐ **If needed** apply for your residence permit (does not apply to everyone!)
- ☐ Open a bank account
- ☐ Connect with your assigned buddy or join our Buddy Program [here](#)
- ☐ Find your local supermarket, pharmacy, shopping area, etc. (Please take note that all shops are entirely closed on Sundays as well as on [public holidays](#))
- ☐ Activate your [IdM](#) account and put in your German address
- ☐ If you are living in a dormitory, hand in your enrolment certificate to the Housing Service (Download on [Campo](#))
- ☐ Buy your [Deutschland Ticket](#) for public transport
